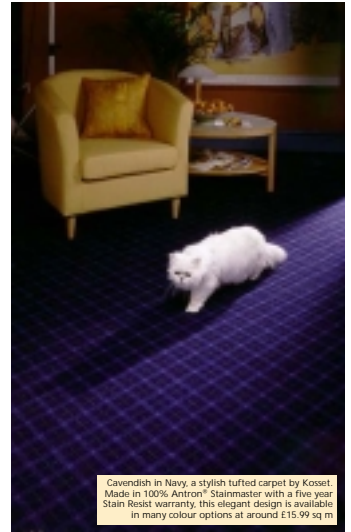


TUFTED & BONDED CARPETS

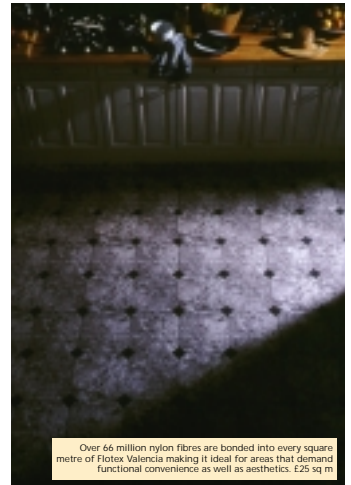
More tufted carpets are produced than any other type of construction and the technical advances over the last 25 years have resulted in a huge choice of styles, textures and qualities. Every type of fibre is represented, from wool to man-made, and some tufted carpets even come with their own integral foam backing. For many years tufted carpets were restricted to using plain or mottled yarns but now sophisticated printing techniques enable the most intricate designs to be created in superb qualities.

A more recent innovation is bonding. This process electrostatically sticks fibre to a pre-formed backing creating a surface which is soft yet extremely hard wearing.

Fusion Bonded carpet involves the pleating of woolrich yarns into a sandwich of carpet which is then slit into two halves to give two carpets with an excellent velvet surface. Since the pile is adhered to the backing, tuft retention is good and the carpet does not fray.
